EANGUS AUXILIARY AWARDS CRITERIA

EANGUS AUXILIARY OUTSTANDING STATE AWARD:

- PURPOSE: To provide recognition to State Auxiliaries which have demonstrated outstanding service at a state and/or national level in the three membership categories.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: Any chartered State Auxiliary in the three membership categories.
 - a. 1-25 Members
 - b. 26-75 Members
 - c. 76 + Members
- 2. CRITERON: The following criterion is established to serve as a guideline in the selection of the State Auxiliaries for this award.
 - a. Organization must have demonstrated exceptionally outstanding service at a state and/or national level.
- 3. NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS & SELECTION PROCEDURES:
 - a. Submission by any EANGUS Auxiliary Executive Council Member.
 - b. Completed nomination form and any additional support documents.
 - c. Nomination packet to be submitted to the EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair by 01 June current year.
 - d. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will review all nominations to ensure individuals meet award criterion.
 - e. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will forward each nomination packet to the Executive Council for a vote.

EANGUS AUXILIARY OUTSTANDING AREA DIRECTOR'S AWARD:

- 1. PURPOSE: To provide recognition to any Area Director who shall distinguish himself/herself with outstanding service to the EANGUS Auxiliary and the respective Auxiliaries within the states that he/she represents.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: Any Area Director currently serving on the Executive Council.
- 3. CRITERIA: Contribution, achievements, service to the EANGUS Auxiliary and the respective Auxiliaries within the states that he/she represents.
- 4. NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS & SELECTION PROCEDURES:
 - a. Submission by any EANGUS Auxiliary Member.
 - b. Completed nomination form and any additional support documents.
 - c. Nomination packet to be submitted to the EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair by 01 June of current year.
 - d. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will review all nominations to ensure individuals meet award criteria.
 - e. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will forward each nomination packet to the Executive Council for a vote.

EANGUS AUXILIARY DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD:

- 1. PURPOSE: To provide significant recognition to any individual who shall distinguish himself/herself with outstanding service at a state and/or national level.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: Any member of the EANGUS Auxiliary not currently serving on the Executive Council.
- 3. CRITERION: The following criterion is established to serve as a guideline in the selection of recipients for this award.
 - a. An individual must have distinguished himself/herself with exceptionally outstanding service at a state and/or national level.

4. NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS & SELECTION PROCEDURES:

- a. Submission by any EANGUS Auxiliary Member.
- b. Completed nomination form and any additional support documents.
- c. Nomination packet to be submitted to the EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair by 01 June of current year.
- d. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will review all nominations to ensure individuals meet award criterion.
- e. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will forward each nomination packet to the Executive Council for a vote.
- f. A maximum of three (3) awards may be given in a single year.

EANGUS AUXILIARY SPOUSE OF THE YEAR AWARD:

- 1. PURPOSE: To provide recognition to the spouse of a member of the EANGUS Auxiliary.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: Any spouse of a member of the EANGUS Auxiliary.
- 3. CRITERIA: This will serve as a guideline in selection of recipient.
 - a. Exceptional support of his/her spouse in his/her service to the EANGUS Auxiliary.
 - b. Additional consideration will be given to involvement in civic affairs, community involvement, and professional activities.

4. NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS & SELECTION PROCEDURES:

- a. Submission by any EANGUS Auxiliary Member.
- b. Completed nomination form and any additional support documents.
- c. Nomination packet to be submitted to the EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair by 01 June of current year.
- d. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will review all nominations to ensure individuals meet award criteria.
- e. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will forward each nomination packet to the Executive Council for a vote.

EANGUS AUXILIARY MERITORIOUS SERVICE AWARD:

- 1. PURPOSE: To recognize an individual's outstanding contributions, achievements, and service to the EANGUS Auxiliary.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: Any member of the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (EANGUS).
- 3. CRITERIA: The following criteria are established to serve as guidelines in the selection of recipients for this award.
 - a. Outstanding performance by the individual must have been such as to clearly identify the nominee as having played a key role in the accomplishments for which this award is to be given.
 - b. Although a single accomplishment may be considered for this award, priority consideration should be given to those individuals who have contributed outstanding service on a sustained basis.
 - c. Personal dedication and self-sacrifice also will be regarded as factors deserving consideration.

4. NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS & SELECTION PROCEDURES:

- a. Submission by any EANGUS Auxiliary Member.
- b. Completed nomination form and any additional support documents.
- c. Nomination packet to be submitted to the EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair by 01 June of current year.
- d. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will review all nominations to ensure individuals meet award criteria.
- e. The EANGUS Auxiliary Awards Chair will forward each nomination packet to the Executive Council for a vote.
- f. A maximum of three (3) awards may be given in a single year.
