History of Memorial Day



Memorial Day, as Decoration Day gradually came to be known, originally honored only those lost while fighting in the Civil War. But during World War I the United States found itself embroiled in another major conflict, and the holiday evolved to commemorate American military personnel who died in all wars, including World War II, The Vietnam War, The Korean War and the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan.

For decades, Memorial Day continued to be observed on May 30, the date General Logan had selected for the first Decoration Day. But in 1968, Congress passed the Uniform Monday Holiday Act, which established Memorial Day as the last Monday in May in order to create a three-day weekend for federal employees. The change went into effect in 1971. The same law also declared Memorial Day a federal holiday.

Memorial Day Traditions and Rituals

Cities and towns across the United States host Memorial Day parades each year, often incorporating military personnel and members of veterans' organizations. Some of the largest parades take place in Chicago, New York and Washington, D.C.

Americans also observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries and memorials. Some people wear a red poppy in remembrance of those fallen in war—a tradition that began with a World War I poem. On a less somber note, many people take weekend trips or throw parties and barbecues on the holiday, perhaps because Memorial Day weekend—the long weekend comprising the Saturday and Sunday before Memorial Day and Memorial Day itself—unofficially marks the beginning of summer.

EANGUS Calls-to-Action

EANGUS Call-to-Action: Stop the forcible removal of the Air National Guard into the Space Force. - On March 15, 2024, Secretary of the Air Force Frank Kendall approved Legislative Proposal 480. This proposal would give the Secretary the full authority to transfer Air National Guard Airmen and units performing space missions into the US Space Force without any approval of the governors that serve as the commander in chief of those Airmen. The exact verbiage of the proposal states "Such transfer shall occur without regard to [section 104 of title 32](#), United States Code, or [section 18238 of title 10](#), United States Code." The two specific sections of law referenced are the code that has established the command structure of the National Guard that has existed for years. This code clearly states the requirement to have a governor's consent to an transfer of the National Guard force structure in their state. By including this in the proposal, the Secretary has circumvented the legal authority that has been given to the states.

EANGUS Call-to-Action, Tricare for Technicians: The Servicemember Healthcare Freedom Act - Healthcare for the Soldiers and Airmen of the National Guard has been a top priority for the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (EANGUS) for years now. EANGUS has been one of the loudest, strongest voices for over a decade for equitable healthcare options for the National Guard; through the creation of Tricare Reserve Select (TRS) to the modern fight of Tricare For All. In that time, a continued fight has existed to ensure that dual status Technicians and their families should be eligible to enroll in Tricare Reserve Select. Enlistment into the military comes with job related benefits of service that are all designed to ensure we maintain the strongest, most capable fighting force in the world. Dual status Technicians are one set of heroes that work continually behind the scenes to ensure the National Guard is "Always Ready, Always There". Without their support, daily military actions, maintenance, training, and readiness do not get accomplished. These Guardsmen, however, remain unable to enroll in Tricare Reserve Select, despite enlisting into service as a benefit, due to a federal law related to Federal Employee Health Benefit (FEHB).

EANGUS Call-to-Action, Reinstate Army National Guard SLRP - The Army National Guard has halted Student Loan Repayment. Due to "unforeseen funding issues," The Army National Guard has ceased paying soldiers for student loan debt. The funding issue is currently isolated within the Student Loan Repayment Program (SLRP). It's unclear whether the service component has notified the more expansive force about the payment holdups.

The Federal student loan repayment program permits agencies to repay federally insured student loans as a recruitment or retention incentive. The average student loan debt for a college graduate in the United States is \$30,000. This can be a significant financial burden, especially for young servicemembers starting their careers.

US Senate, EANGUS, Health Care for Our Troops - EANGUS strongly supports the re-introduction of S. 5142 Healthcare for Our Troops Act, introduced during the 117th Congress. This legislation would have provided Reserve Component (R.C.) servicemembers with zero-cost TRICARE insurance. Additionally, this legislation expands TRICARE eligibility to R.C. servicemembers currently working for the federal government in their civilian capacity.

EANGUS Call-to-Action: Health Care for Our Troops - EANGUS strongly supports H.R. 4221, the Healthcare for Our Troops Act. This legislation would provide Reserve Component (R.C.) servicemembers with zero-cost TRICARE insurance. Additionally, this legislation expands TRICARE eligibility to R.C. servicemembers currently working for the federal government in their civilian capacity.

One of the best benefits of retiring and turning age 65 is TRICARE for Life. TRICARE for Life, or TFL for short, was enacted into law by Congress in the Fiscal Year 2001 National Defense Authorization Act (Public Law 106-398). TFL is Medicare-wraparound coverage if you are TRICARE-eligible and have Medicare Part A (inpatient care) and B (outpatient care), regardless of age or place of residence. It is not a Medicare Advantage plan but it acts like one. There are no enrollment fees.

Each year, the Chief of the National Guard Bureau provides a policy statement that includes travel and funding guidance for federal funding being used to attend the EANGUS Conference. This policy gives the states the authority to spend federal funds on travel for selected members of the National Guard to attend the EANGUS conference while in an official duty status. The policy includes authorized amounts per person, administrative absence guidelines, and some pay and allowance options for units to take.

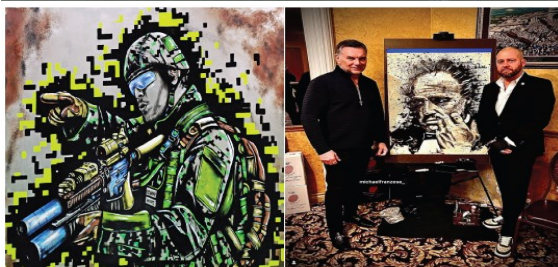

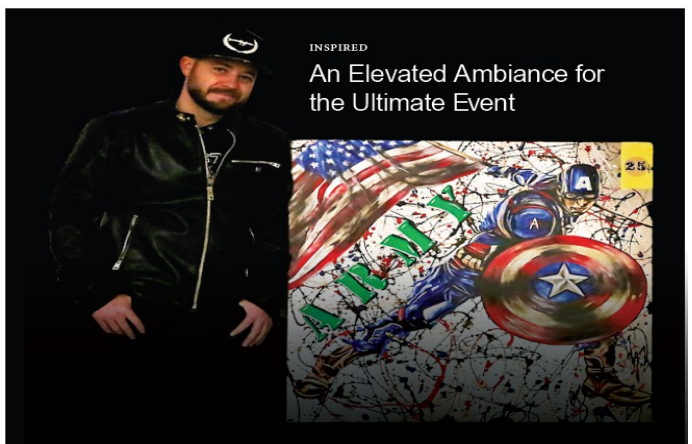

The National Guard Relief Foundation provides emergency financial assistance to the men and women of the National Guard and their families and has been taking care of them since its origination in 1992. We currently offer both Grants as well as Interest-Free Loans to members of the National Guard Community. Generous donations from USAA over the last several years allowed us to assist thousands of National Guard members during the COVID-19 Pandemic and funded the establishment of our loan program. Since 2004, We Care for America has provided over \$2.9M in Grants and Interest-Free Loans to National Guard members needing assistance.

Assistance can be provided to qualified Enlisted personnel, Officers, and Warrant Officers who have experienced a financial emergency related to events such as a mobilization, natural disasters, fires, catastrophic losses, or other hardships. Funds are intended for otherwise non-reimbursable expenses (i.e., those not covered by insurance) due to an emergency or hardship, and include medical bills, utility bills, rent/mortgage payments, groceries, relocation/moving expenses, shelter due to loss of residence, and funeral expenses. Other expenses not listed here, may be deemed appropriate for a grant or loan subject to approval.

NOTE: EANGUS membership is not required to apply or be eligible for a National Guard Relief Foundation Grant or Interest Free Loan.
